### **Notes**

1. In Britain we are seeing the rapid growth of UKIP, a right wing, racist, populist party.
2. UKIP made a major breakthrough in the European Parliamentary Elections in May 2014. It came first in the election polling 27.5% of the vote. There are now 24 UKIP Euro MEPs. Also UKIP have come second or third in the last 5 by-elections and gained 160 councillors in May 2014.
3. The success of UKIP mirrors the growth of far right racist and fascist parties across much of Europe.
4. The formation of Stand up to UKIP, a broad based campaign which includes leading trade unionists, MPs and community organisations which are coming together to oppose UKIP.

### **Believes**

1. UKIP is a racist, bigoted and anti trade union party.
2. Migrants are not responsible for the lack of affordable housing, the break up of the NHS or the economic crisis. Anti immigrant racism must have no place in our movement and therefore should be opposed.
3. Our trades unions must campaign for a raising of living standards for all, we must oppose the bosses race to the bottom.
4. The success of UKIP is pushing the mainstream parties further to the right.
